Infant Learning Program (ILP) can work with you to discover ways to help your child learn and grow. ILP provides home visits for families of children birth - 3 years old who have developmental concerns, including the following services:

- Developmental screening and evaluation
- Hearing and vision screenings
- Family Service Coordination
- Parent education classes & supports
- Early Intervention including:
  - Special Education
  - Occupational Therapy
  - Physical Therapy
  - Speech Language Therapy
  - Vision services
  - Infant Mental Health
  - Other services based on individual need
